Málaga is a candidate alongside Minnesota (USA), San Carlos de Bariloche (Argentina), Phuket (Thailand) and Belgrade (Serbia) The candidature has the support of the Spanish government, the Andalucían regional government, the county council and Málaga city council and more than 260 companies and institutions

Málaga is a touristic, innovative city and the economic and technological capital of Andalucía



The city has recorded more than 19.8 million passengers with direct flights to more than a hundred destinations from Málaga airport and more than 30 million rail passengers since 2007 The city has first-class land, rail, sea and air infrastructures, with a sound business network that includes Google, Vodafone, Oracle, Dekra and TDK, among others, and a superior tourism industry



 It is also a cultural hub with 60,000 m<sup>2</sup> of exhibition space and 39 museums After the Expo, the infrastructures shall accommodate educational, scientific and innovative spaces and a business park. Furthermore, the plots located to the east and west of the main site, which will be used for residential and logistical purposes during the event, will allow Málaga to increase its housing stock and expand the Freight Transport Centre
