

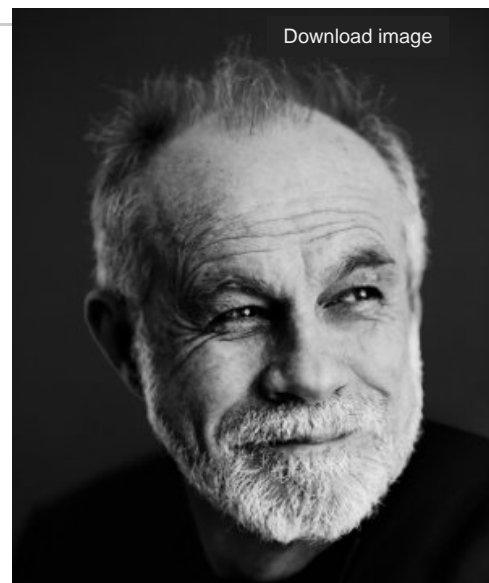
Carlos Moreno
